

Ignoring this warning can lead to injury and/or cause serious damage.


This transducer is a build-in device, whose conducting parts must be inaccessible after installation.

# **Remarks**

- $I_{\rm S}$  is positive when  $U_{\rm P}$  is applied on terminal + HT.
- The primary circuit of the transducer must be linked to the connections where the voltage has to be measured.
